Planning to apply for the Cook County Emergency Rental Assistance Program? Start gathering your supporting documents now so you're ready to go. Applications open **October 4, 2021** and will be accepted until **October 29, 2021**.

Step 1: Check Your Eligibility

If you answered yes to all four questions, you are eligible to apply.

Step 2: Gather Required Documents

<input type="checkbox"/>	Photo identification	Government Issued ID • State ID <i>OR</i> • Driver's license <i>OR</i> • Passport <i>OR</i> • Other ID
<input type="checkbox"/>	A list of everyone who lives in your household and verification of current monthly household income	• W-2 or tax filings <i>OR</i> • Unemployment benefits <i>OR</i> • Paystubs or bank statements
<input type="checkbox"/>	Proof of COVID-related financial emergency	• Unemployment claim dated after March 13, 2020 <i>OR</i> • Notice from your employer on company letterhead that states you have been laid off or furloughed, or had a reduction in work hours <i>OR</i> • Copies of medical bills, childcare expenses, or other significant costs the household incurred since March 13, 2020 • If you are self-employed: Paystubs or bank statements showing decreased income after March 1, 2020
<input type="checkbox"/>	Latest utility bill (if applying for utility assistance)	• Gas and/or electric bill
<input type="checkbox"/>	Your landlord's name and email address	

What if I have other housing-related assistance needs?

You may also be eligible to receive help with other expenses including relocation expenses, security deposits, late fees, and temporary housing solutions.

When applying, submit proof of other housing-related need as well.
