Sheryl discussed:

Project location-850 E Northwest Hwy, Palatine, Illinois 60074

Land sq. ft.: 19,140 sq. ft,

Building sq. ft.: 2,020 sq. ft.

Property Tax Savings for applicant: \$708,705

Total Project Cost: \$3,342,906

Private capital investment to tax incentive savings = 4.7 to 1

Job creation: 3 full-time jobs, 3 part-time jobs, 25 construction jobs
